We are hugely indebted to Ian and thank him most sincerely. We wish Andrew Beattie, his successor, every blessing as he steps into this important role.

Emma Bowles, our office administrator on Thursday and Friday mornings, continues to work with great energy and willingness to lighten the administration workload for us. She has been a real blessing.

We are most grateful to our Property Convener and Sexton, David McCullough, who works tirelessly and cheerfully to keep our premises in ship-shape condition. Malcolm McKeown has now taken over as our Graveyard Convener from Gordon Forsythe. We are very grateful to Gordon for his years of sterling service and assure Malcolm of our prayers as he settles into this role.

We are greatly blessed to have so many gifted musicians and vocalists in Newmills who give of their gifts and talents selflessly week by week on a rota basis. Thanks to everyone who contributes to leading our worship – such a vital ministry!

Our Sound and Screen teams under the direction of Sam Leslie, do a quiet but incredible work each Sunday, upstairs at the 'Control Desk'. Their work is very specialised and so we're very grateful to them for their willingness to use their skills for us in this way.

We said 'farewell' to our assistant, Mark Hawthorne, at the end of 2024, and we continue to pray for him, Laura and the family in these early days of ministry in Legacurry. I want to thank our current assistant, Daniel, for his help and personal support over the past couple of years, as he continues to train and prepare for ministry, wherever the Lord should lead him in due course. We are thankful too, to have Kate and wee Joe worshipping with us at this time.

Sincere thanks are due to all our leaders, helpers and volunteers who shoulder the responsibility of our weekly and monthly organisations. Their commitment and sacrifice of time and energy are deeply appreciated by us all. I trust that they have been encouraged this year as they have served in their particular area of our church family life.

I am extremely grateful for a team of very supportive and encouraging elders. Their wisdom, perspective and heart for God are greatly appreciated. I'm especially thankful for our Clerk of Session, Stephen Sharpe, who is ever-patient, gracious and helpful.

Our Congregational Committee have been busy in 2024, overseeing the sale of the church bungalow and preparing plans and costs for the proposed new build, hopefully due to begin in the summer. Special thanks are due again to Bertie Wilson who has been working tirelessly on behalf of the Vision Sub Committee to deliver this for us. Jim Freeburn continues to act as our Congregational Secretary and carries out his duties with quiet efficiency and gentle humour.

In 2024, we recorded 6 infant baptisms, 1 adult baptism, 2 weddings and 20 funerals. It is always a privilege to pastor in both the happiest and saddest of times.

As time moves on, we are aware of the changing scenes of life, and that nothing ever stays the same forever. How wonderful it is to know that the eternal and unchanging God who is the same yesterday, today and forever, is holding onto us and will never lose sight of us. MONEY MATTERS

Please see later in this annual report the details of the financial contributions to the congregation

and all of it's work in 2024. Below we have highlighted certain statistics for your attention but in advance of you reading any of that, we wish to record our sincerest thanks to the congregation for their generosity throughout 2024. The job of managing the church finances is made less onerous when people give generously and we are able to pay the bills, support the ongoing work and (in line with the wishes of the Church Committee) approve requests for financial support for new initiatives. We are mindful always that your contributions are given with the express purpose of continuing God's work in Newmills, in those parts of the world where we have relationships with our brothers and sisters in Christ and to other worthy causes.

During 2024 giving to our various funds increased. The main source of income is freewill offering which increased by over 13%. There is a corresponding increase in gift aid arising from this increase and increases in giving to other funds. Gift aid for the year 2024 amounted to almost £63,000. This is distributed around the various funds in line with the intention of the original donations. We reiterate again the importance of collecting every penny of income via Gift Aid. If you happen to be new to the congregation and are a taxpayer or have become a taxpayer, please speak to Alan Dowey about gift aid. The process of sign up is very straight forward. We encourage all our young adults who have moved into employment to consider this to maximise the benefit of their donations.

The Harvest Appeal (traditionally used for renovation and maintenance of our properties) increased significantly from £13k in 2023 to almost £26k in 2024 which reflects among the congregation a most encouraging, early interest in and support for the forthcoming building project.

The interest of the congregation in Mission remains appropriately a high priority. Giving to the Missions Appeal almost doubled and this enabled the Missions sub-committee to continue giving to a wide range of local and international mission organisations and to increase the amounts donated.

Further details can be found in the accounts later in this report. These figures are most encouraging and reflect a giving heart on behalf of the congregation.

The Church committee decided to invest some of our reserves in a fixed term deposit account for 12 months. This investment will mature in 2025 and should accrue over £11.000 in interest. In addition, the committee decided to sell the 'Sexton's Bungalow' in anticipation of the building project. The sale exceeded expectations and the proceeds will be reflected in the accounts for 2025.

We make our usual appeal to any contributing member of the congregation who does not give online to consider doing so. A helpsheet is available at the back of the church giving details of the church bank accounts and the purposes for each. This helps us in the Finance sub-committee to track donations more easily. We will ensure for September that this information is also on the screens in church on Sunday. Perhaps the best strategy would be to take a photo of this which means you have it handy when needed. Please feel free to do so.

If you have any queries on financial matters, please speak to any of the Finance sub-committee and we will endeavour to answer your query.

We express our thanks for their dedication to our team of counters: Mark Dowey, Diane Elliott, Ian Elliott, Samantha Freeburn, Jill Gough and Sharon McCord. This vital role is a largely unseen one which continues year round with no break. Their commitment is much appreciated.

Over the next 18 months we will face a change in leadership and a building project which will bring both challenge and anticipation. As a Finance sub-committee we would encourage everyone to continue prayerfully considering their giving during this time. & Mlona S

RULES RELATING TO NEWMILLS GRAVEYARD

- 1. The exclusive right of burial shall be granted in perpetuity to the purchasers thereof, their heirs and assigns.
- 2. Persons wishing to have interments carried out must give not less than 48 hours notice.
- 3. New graves shall be at least 6 feet deep.
- 4. No coffin or urn shall be laid in any grave nearer to the surface of the ground than 3' 6" therefrom, measured from the upper surface.
- 5. A register of burials will be kept.
- 6. No monuments, headstones or surrounds shall be erected in the graveyard or inscription be put on any monument without the consent of the Congregational Committee.
- 7. All wreaths will be moved from the grave six weeks after interment.
- 8. All rubbish shall be disposed of in the skip provided.
- 9. A person erecting a monument shall remove all debris resulting from the erection and shall make good any damage done to turf, shrubbery, adjacent monuments or walks, all at his own expense.
- 10. The erection of pillars, hoops, railings, fences or other structures for the purpose of enclosing graves is expressly prohibited.
- 11. All graves that are being left in turf shall be reinstated in due course by the Church Committee.
- 12. No person shall plant shrubs or trees in any part of the graveyard.
- 13. All fees for purchase, opening of and reinstatement of graves, shall be paid immediately.
- 14. The Committee cannot be held responsible for damage to grave plots, wreaths, headstones, surrounds, etc.
- 15. Burial Privilege Church Members £75, Non-members £150
- 16. Memorial Erection £50

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR AREA 2

- 17. The graves in Area 2 will be dug to face East and West. In this area HEADSTONES ONLY will be permitted.
- 18. All graves in Area 2 will be left in grass.
- 19. To facilitate grass cutting, permanent wreaths will not be permitted in this area.
- 20. Current cost of a two grave plot is £150 and is available for Church Members only.
- 21. Graves will be sold for burials of the purchaser and their immediate family.
