We are indebted to our Finance Sub-Committee, Ian McConaghy (Treasurer), Judith Dowey, Tim Boyle and Emma Bowles for their recent sterling work, in preparing the 2021 accounts. This is still a 'new team' with a huge task, not just finalising the accounts, but preparing our Gift Aid Claim, submitting our report to the Charities Commission and compiling this Annual Report. Sincere thanks to each one for the unseen work and many hours given over to this task. We welcomed our new Church Administrator, Emma Bowles in December 2021. Emma, who attends Vinecash Presbyterian, has settled in really well and taken on some new administrative responsibilities under the direction of the Finance Sub-Committee. She works in the office most Wednesday and Friday mornings if you need to contact her.

2021 was a very traumatic year for our assistant, Richard Hill as he and Louise lost their precious little boy Theo to Cancer. Richard has paused his ministry training for the time-being, but we do of course continue to remember them in our prayers, as they grieve and lean on God's grace for daily strength and hope. We welcomed Mark Hawthorne, his wife Laura and children, Josiah, Zac and Rebekah in September. As I write, Mark is finishing his student assistant year and is about to move into a full-time position with us. We look forward to getting to know the whole family better in the next few years and appreciate all that they've contributed already to our congregational life.

As always, we pay tribute to those who work behind the scenes to keep the practical side of church life going. David McCullough has been assiduous in his caretaking duties and has now also taken on the role of Property Convener. Gordon Forsythe fulfilled this role for many years with exceptional diligence. We are hugely indebted to Gordon and assure David of our support as he takes on these additional responsibilities.

Many visitors to Newmills comment on the great music and praise! We are dependant on a large team of musicians and vocalists, anchored by Mary McConkey at the organ and Shirley Wilson on the piano. Additionally, we have a very hard-working team of screen operators, sound and camera technicians, headed up by Sam Leslie, who turn up faithfully each week. I know that our online recordings are deeply appreciated by those watching the services from home. Few of us have any idea of the work involved in all this, but we're extremely grateful to each one.

I am blessed with a very supportive team of elders and have particularly appreciated their wisdom during the past two years. I'm especially grateful to our Session Clerk, Stephen Sharpe, for his constant encouragement. On our recently elected Church Committee, we have welcomed five new members, with whom we look forward to serving alongside. Jim Freeburn, our Congregational Secretary continues in this role with quiet dedication and efficiency.

Thanks too, to the army of organisational leaders, helpers and volunteers on the various teams and rotas. They have had to work their way through the 'stopstart' of Covid and have been marvellously patient in the midst of frustrating times. Most organisations are back up and running and we hope to see the remainder operating, God willing, in September. We constantly need help in all of these, so please consider giving us some of your time and energy when appeals go out, if as yet you are not greatly involved in church family life.

In 2021, we recorded three infant baptisms, one adult baptism, two weddings and six funerals. It is a privilege for me to share in these family occasions, both happy and sad, and to journey with all families in our fellowship, especially as they walk through tough times of sickness, anxiety, uncertainty and loss. Thank you for allowing me to share in these times and to point you to Jesus, who is our strength when we are weak. In return, we in the Manse are ever thankful and often overwhelmed by your continued love, prayers and generous support. We look forward to continuing to serve our faithful Lord for another year as He cheers us on our way and pours out yet more blessings upon us.

Money Matters 2021

Whilst the covid pandemic continued to have an impact on all our lives during 2021, including church services and attendance, the figures above represent a continuation of generous giving on behalf of the congregation. It is an encouragement to see the commitment to Missions demonstrated in a healthy sum donated for this purpose, which is much appreciated by the individuals and organisations who receive allocated funds from us. The United Appeal and Harvest Appeal have also both been the recipient of generous giving by the congregation. The reduction in loose offering is to be expected given the method of collecting our worship offerings in church has changed.

The continued healthy giving to freewill offerings throughout a very difficult and unusual year is a real encouragement and the support of the congregation is much appreciated. Giving through periods of lockdown has been facilitated by online giving from an increasing number of people who find it convenient. We would also remind our members who are tax payers to sign up for Gift Aid. The Gift Aid Scheme is of significant financial benefit to the church and we would encourage anyone who gives on a regular basis and who is eligible to fill in the appropriate form. If you are a tax payer who is eligible for signing a Gift Aid Declaration, or would like to be removed from the Gift Aid claim due to a change in your tax status, please contact the church office or inform a member of the finance team.

The counting team has been reduced in size since many members of the congregation now donate via online banking. The team was further reduced due to the pandemic for the year 2021. Continuing to count the cash throughout the year was Judith Dowey, Zeke McCleary and Gillian Shepherd. Their contribution to this important work is much appreciated. We want to thank Rab Cassells, David McCullough and Paul Ryan for their commitment as counters in previous years.

The Finance Team appreciated the work of the Gillian Shepherd during the first part of the year and then welcomed our new Finance and Administration Officer, Emma Bowles towards the end of the financial year. It was and is a pleasure to work with both and we offer our thanks to them along with Judith Dowey our Church Donations Coordinator for helping to keep the finance records in good shape throughout the year and for their assistance in preparing this report.

Rules Relating To Newmills Graveyard

- 1. The exclusive right of burial shall be granted in perpetuity to the purchasers thereof, their heirs and assigns.
- 2. Persons wishing to have interments carried out must give not less than 48 hours notice.
- 3. New graves shall be at least 6 feet deep.
- 4. No coffin or urn shall be laid in any grave nearer to the surface of the ground than 3' 6" therefrom, measured from the upper surface.
- 5. A register of burials will be kept.
- 6. No monuments, headstones or surrounds shall be erected in the graveyard or inscription be put on any monument without the consent of the Congregational Committee.
- 7. All wreaths will be moved from the grave six weeks after interment.
- 8. All rubbish shall be disposed of in the skip provided.
- 9. A person erecting a monument shall remove all debris resulting from the erection and shall make good any damage done to turf, shrubbery, adjacent monuments or walks, all at his own expense.
- 10. The erection of pillars, hoops, railings, fences or other structures for the purpose of enclosing graves is expressly prohibited.
- 11. All graves that are being left in turf shall be reinstated in due course by the Church Committee.
- 12. No person shall plant shrubs or trees in any part of the graveyard.
- 13. All fees for purchase, opening of and reinstatement of graves, shall be paid immediately.
- 14. The Committee cannot be held responsible for damage to grave plots, wreaths, headstones, surrounds, etc.
- 15. Burial Privilege Church Members £75, Non-members £150
- 16. Memorial Erection £50

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR AREA 2

- 17. The graves in Area 2 will be dug to face East and West. In this area HEADSTONES ONLY will be permitted.
- 18. All graves in Area 2 will be left in grass.
- 19. To facilitate grass cutting, permanent wreaths will not be permitted in this area.
- 20. Current cost of a two grave plot is £150 and is available for Church Members only.
- 21. Graves will be sold for burials of the purchaser and their immediate family.
